Pandikuzhi	A popular picnic spot, it offers great opportunities for trekking and is a photographer's delight.	77 Kilometers
Ramakalmedu	Offers a Panoramic view of picturesque villages of Bodi and Cumbum on the Eastern slop of the western Ghats.	100 Kilometers
Munnar	The most sought after tourist destination in South India. This panoramic hill station commands spectacular views of low-flying clouds and misty valleys.	130 Kilometers
